




How to ... ?	Create a shortcut on an Infor OS homepage using an automation link
Prerequisite	Knowledge in <i>Mforms automation builder</i>
Result	 <p>This “Menu” widget embedded on an Infor OS homepage contains three shortcuts. All are created using automation links.</p> <p>The two first ones drive the user to POS100 panel E and prefill some fields in (project type, project template...).</p> <p>The third one allows the user to go directly in POS100 panel B for displaying projects created.</p>


Steps for creating shortcut

#1 Get the logical ID of the M3 environment


Select the “User Menu” in the title bar



In the “Admin Settings” section from Infor OS




Double-click on the M3 environment to use



#3 Create the shortcut in the “Menu” widget

Create a new shortcut with “+” button



Enter a name

Enter the URL

Note: The URL is the combination of the logical ID (see step #1) and the link generated by Mforms automation builder (see step #2) and must be formatted as below:

?LogicalId=**lid://infor.m3.sbx**&**TASK=mforms...**

And that's it!

Note: the link created with *Mforms automation builder* can also be embedded in a H5 shortcut. In that case, it will be created using format “Mforms uri (encoded)” instead of “Task parameter”. The prefix “mforms” will must be deleted. So, the link should start by “_automation?data=...”. For a usage in SmartOffice, the prefix “mforms” must be kept.
